Equality Now is an international human rights organization with ECOSOC status working to protect and promote the rights of women and girls worldwide since 1992, including through our membership network of individuals and organizations in over 160 countries.

The National Council of Women Leaders (NCWL) is a coalition of women leaders who belong to marginalized communities across India working at the grassroots to support and empower marginalized women and girls in their communities.

The **Dalit Human Rights Defenders Network (DHRDNet)** is a coalition of over 1000 Dalit human rights defenders from across India.
