However, the fact remains that all State Parties have an onus to combat CSE both domestically as well as outside of their nation's borders regardless of how and by whom those borders are drawn. Palestinian children should be protected from CSE. Besides that, the GoI has a special duty of care as many children flee the OPT into the territory of the State of Israel and survive through prostitution without any state support.</p>

Tasking a group of NGOs that operate out of Israel and Palestine may be a means of facilitating both preliminary, as well as consistent, contact between the requisite parties needed to assess the situation of CSE in the OPT as well as support the prevention of children surviving through prostitution after they flee the OPT.</p>
