- How will the government ensure the implementation of the right to safe drinking water and sanitation for the entire population, in particular in rural areas?
- Considering the high maternal mortality rate, what steps has the government taken to extend health insurance coverage, and in particular, to counter the high maternal mortality rates among adolescents?
- What steps are being taken to close the wage gap between women and men and to ensure equal pay for equal work, as recommended by CESCR?
- What steps have been taken to criminalize domestic servitude, as recommended by the special rapporteur on slavery?
- What steps have been taken to address concerns expressed by CESCR and CEDAW regarding the classification of consensual sexual relations between adolescents as statutory rape and the penalization of abortion in cases of pregnancy resulting from rape? How will Peru address the negative effects of raising the age of consent for sexual relations on the sexual and reproductive health of teenagers?
- How is human rights education being implemented in educational institutions?
- What steps have been taken to implement CESCR recommendation on raising the minimum age for admission to employment to 15 years of age?
- What progress has been made with regard to the prohibition of corporal punishment of children in all settings?
- What steps have been taken to implement the decisions of the Human Rights Committee in the case of K.L. v. Peru and of the CEDAW committee in the case of L.C. v. Peru? In particular, what follow-up has been given to the recommendation to establish a mechanism for effective access to therapeutic abortion under conditions that protect the physical and mental health of women?
