In this regard we call upon Saudi Arabia to step up the process to allow other Islamic women and all women the knowledge to realize the extent of their rights in order to overcome the confusion between the true Islamic Shari's and customs and traditions. In this regard I laude the efforts to bring in women from other countries in conferences to add to this process. This will also assist in educating the public so that women can drive freely in Saudi Arabia. We must remember that all countries have had to overcome prejudice against women in many areas, including violence. As a child I recall the prejudice of against women drivers even in the United States which included high insurance rates. Saudi Arabia can also overcome this.
