

ADVANCE QUESTIONS TO SAN MARINO

LIECHTENSTEIN

- Liechtenstein recognises San Marino's commitment to international criminal justice, as evidenced by its continued support for the International Criminal Court and its ratification of the Kampala amendment to Article 8 of the Rome Statute.
- What steps has San Marino taken to ratify the Kampala amendments to the Rome Statute on the crime of aggression, to accede to the Agreement on Privileges and Immunities of the Court (APIC) and to fully align its national legislation with the Rome Statute, including by incorporating the definition of crimes and principles of cooperation?

NETHERLANDS

- Does the Government of San Marino intend to ratify the Convention on Cybercrime and its Additional Protocol, and did it take any action in this respect?
- What action did San Marino take in order to provide the Equal Opportunities Commission with the competence to combat racism and racial discrimination, make it independent from the Government and provide it with sufficient means to fulfill its tasks effectively, as recommended by the European Commission against Racism and Intolerance of the Council of Europe?
- Is the Government of San Marino prepared to establish a procedure for processing asylum applications and adjudicating asylum cases, and what action has been taken so far?
- Can the Government of San Marino indicate when it will meet its reporting obligations to the UN treaty bodies?

UNITED KINGDOM

- We note that San Marino has committed to tackling the problem of delays in the submission of periodic reports to the monitoring bodies of the United Nations. What steps is the Government taking?

- What steps have been taken by the Government of San Marino to prohibit discrimination on the grounds of sexual orientation and gender identity?
