

ADVANCE QUESTIONS TO CABO VERDE (FIRST BATCH)

UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND

- Since Law 84/VII/11 on gender-based violence was passed in 2011, what progress has the Government made on reducing domestic violence?
- What further assistance or resources do the law enforcement authorities require to effectively prevent people trafficking through Cape Verde?
- What is the Government doing to tackle people trafficking through Cape Verde?
- Is the Government considering a National Strategy on Disabilities or any other similar mechanism in order to ensure that it fulfils its obligations as a State party to the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities?
- How does the Government enforce compulsory primary education for girls and ensure that secondary education is available for girls, in line with the Convention on the Rights of the Child?

GERMANY

- Regarding the German recommendation in the second UPR cycle accepted by Cape Verde: What measures have been taken to eliminate the existing discriminatory stereotypes regarding the roles and responsibilities of women and men in family as well as in society at large?
- What is the status of the proposed new parity law?
- What steps are being taken to set up a National Preventive Mechanism as foreseen by the OP-CAT?

SLOVENIA

- Slovenia would like to inquire on the timeline to establish the national prevention mechanism in accordance with the Optional Protocol to CAT.
