- What steps is the Government of Tuvalu taking to promote and ensure girls education at primary and secondary level?
- What plans does the Government of Tuvalu have to ratify the ILO Convention concerning the Prohibition and Immediate Action for the Elimination of the Worst Forms of Child Labour, 1999 (No. 182)?
