

## ADVANCE QUESTIONS TO NORWAY (SECOND BATCH)

### SLOVENIA

- The Committee on the Rights of the Child recommended that Norway establish (or strengthen) a national mechanism for reporting and follow-up as a standing government structure, mandated to coordinate and prepare reports to and engage with international and regional human rights mechanisms, and coordinate national follow-up to and implementation of the treaty obligations and the recommendations of such mechanisms. We would like to ask how the Government of Norway intend to implement this recommendation - how this "standing government structure" will look like and how it will function.
- Following the Summary of Stakeholders` submissions, reports shedding light on past assimilation practices against the Tater/Romani and the Roma minorities were published in Norway. The authorities apologised for these practices and adopted compensation schemes and other reparation measures. We would like to ask the Norway delegation to give us some more information on this issue.
